- 2. Execute implementation of landscape design plan, including sourcing and purchasing of all necessary supplies and equipment.
- Create, maintain and evolve methods for tracking farm operations and data, including crop plans, energy and labor consumption, harvest log, germination rate, planting schedule, growth schedule, soil and nutrition management and soil testing across all farm areas.
- 4. Manage weekly farm schedule, and farm-wide policies and procedures.
- 5. Manage all farm distribution efforts, including farm stands, CSA and wholesale and donation distribution.
- 6. Develop and maintain farm infrastructure.
